

Video communications for those opposed to HB-1315.

Instructions:

1. This is a suggested script for your video. Remember to keep your comments short and to the point. Your video message must not be more than 40-45 seconds. The message we need to tell is to “vote NO on HB 1315.”
2. Your video doesn’t have to be fancy. Your heartfelt message of concern can be a good smartphone video-selfie as long as you are plainly seen and your voice is easily understood.
3. Use the following as a guideline but the language for the bad parts of the bill need to be accurate.
4. Follow the KISS principle: keep it short, and simple!

- They will not have to instruct kids about child abuse and child sexual abuse.
- They won’t have to check employee references.
